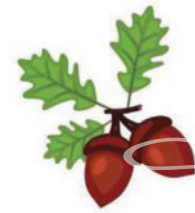

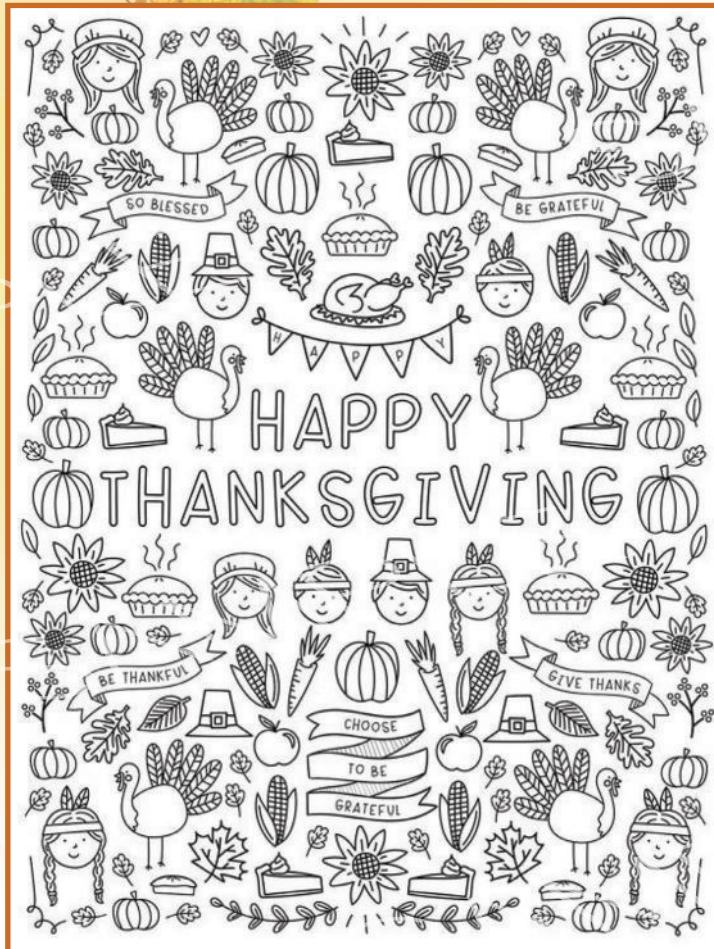

IS YOUR CAR READY FOR THANKSGIVING TRAVEL?

Inspect Your Vehicle - One of the easiest things you can do for your and others' safety is by taking your vehicle to Heartland Auto Repair for a pre-trip inspection. Easy Homemade Dinner Rolls

This is my way of making fluffy, light and buttery dinner rolls. My recipe is EASY and quick to prep, and the rolls turn out absolutely beautiful.



Prep Time: 30 mins • Cook Time: 20 mins • Rise: 1 hour • Total: 1 hour 50 mins

Ingredients	For Rolls:	For Brushing:
	• 1 envelope active dried yeast	• 2 tablespoons sugar
	• ½ cup water about room temperature warm, see notes	• 4 cups all-purpose flour or more if needed
	• 1 cup milk whole milk or 2% preferred	• ½ tablespoon salt
	• 4 tablespoons butter melted	

Directions

1. Activate yeast and combine liquid ingredients. Whisk the yeast into the warm water in a small bowl and set aside until bubbles start to appear on the surface. In the meantime, whisk together the milk, melted butter and sugar. Add the activated yeast mixture and whisk until combined.
2. Make dough: Add the flour and salt to the bowl of your stand mixer fitted with the hook attachment. Add the milk mixture, then knead on medium-low speed for 5-6 minutes, or until you have a smooth ball of dough. Add an extra tablespoon of flour if your dough feels too sticky!
3. Rise: Cover the bowl with a clean kitchen towel and let stand at room temperature for 1 hour, or until doubled in size. Punch down, then divide dough into 12 equal pieces; shape into balls. Place in greased 9x11 inch baking pan. Cover and let rise at room temperature until big and puffed up, about 20-30 minutes.
4. Bake: Heat the oven to 375°F. Beat the egg and egg wash the top of the rolls (you will most likely not use the entire egg; don't add too much or you'll have scrambled eggs on top of your rolls). Bake for around 20 minutes or until done. Brush with additional melted butter right as they come out of the oven, if you like. Remove from the pan and serve warm.

THE THANKSGIVING STORY

The Thanksgiving holiday traces its origins back to 1621, when the Pilgrims, a group of English settlers, celebrated their first successful harvest in Plymouth, Massachusetts. After a harsh winter in which nearly half of the Pilgrims died, the remaining settlers were able to grow crops and survive with the help of the Wampanoag tribe. The Native Americans, led by Chief Massasoit, taught the Pilgrims vital skills such as farming, fishing, and foraging.

To express gratitude, the Pilgrims invited the Wampanoag to join them in a feast that lasted for three days. Together, they shared foods like corn, venison, and fish, marking what many consider the first Thanksgiving. The event symbolized cooperation and unity between the two groups, though relations between settlers and Native Americans would become strained in later years. Thanksgiving became an official U.S. holiday in 1863, when President Abraham Lincoln declared it a national day of thanks during the Civil War. Today, it's celebrated with family gatherings, food, and reflection on gratitude.
